

TUITION INFORMATION

Eastern Panhandle Christian Academy Tuition for 2011-2012

Registration Fee

Registration Fee per student (includes grades PK4-12, and testing if applicable), non-refundable.

\$50 - if paid by May 31, 2011 (last day of 2011-2012 school year)

\$100 - if postmarked (sent by mail) or paid by June 30, 2011

\$150 - if postmarked after or paid anytime after June 30, 2011

(If registration is after August 3, 2011 and spots are still available, there may be a delay in the students start date.)

Curriculum/Supplies Fee

Curriculum/Supplies Fee per student (includes grades PK4-12) - \$200 per year. Can be paid in four, \$50.00 monthly installments. The first installment is due by the first day of class. The remaining three installments are due by the 15th of each consecutive month following.

Tuition Rate

\$3,500.00 / year - Tuition Rate for the first child enrolled.

\$1,750.00 / year - Tuition Rate for each extra siblings up to 3 per family.

NOTE: 1 full tuition per 4 students enrolled. Sibling is full/half brother or sister either by natural relation or through adoption.

Tuition Payment Policy

The Parent/Guardian will have the option to pay the student's tuition in full or have it divided into ten monthly payments. Tuition is due by the first day of class. For monthly payers, the first payment is due by the first day of class, then on the 15th of each following month thereafter, until May 15th. If tuition is paid in full by the student's first day of class, a 10% discount will be applied to the Tuition Rate after prorated & sibling discounts are applied.

Discounts and Fees

When a student is enrolled later in the school year, a prorated discount is applied to the Tuition for the portion of the year that was not attended. In the case of a late enrollment, the Registration Fee, first Tuition Payment, and Curriculum/Supply Fee is due by the student's first day of class.

In the case of early withdrawal, dis-enrollment, or permanent suspension, a prorated discount will be applied to the student's account for the portion of the year that was not attended. However an early withdrawal fee may be applied to the discount.

A late fee may be assessed if tuition payment becomes 15 days past due. A recovery fee may be assessed if computer equipment is intentional abused or damage by the student. All Parents/Guardians must sign a Tuition Payment Contract. See the back of this page for the contract.
